Gorgon Project Plant Site



 Gorgon Project work continues to progress with the installation of the second of three amine absorbers, two condensate stabilization modules and a recycled gas compression module (center).



Gas Turbine Generators Under Construction



 Foundations have been poured for all five gas turbine generators (GTGs), with two GTGs placed on their foundations. The GTGs will provide standalone electrical power generation for the LNG plant and associated facilities.



Progress on the LNG Jetty



 Work continues on the 1.3-mile (2.1-km) LNG jetty with 24 caissons in place. Installation of the jetty roadways is under way.



Permanent Operations Center



 Construction on the Gorgon Operations Center is progressing well at the Permanent Operations Facility site.



Production Pipeline Construction



The Solitaire, one of the world's largest pipe-laying vessels, is currently laying the 34-inch (86-cm) production pipeline to the Jansz-lo gas field.



Installed Subsea Umbilicals



 Subsea umbilicals have been installed from the shore crossing site on Barrow Island to the Gorgon and Jansz-lo gas fields. Totaling 121 miles (195 km), the umbilicals connect the subsea equipment to the LNG plant.
